#### A NOTE FROM OUR FOUNDERS

In 2024, Madelyn's Fund expanded its reach to support more NICU families across the Carolinas, offering vital assistance amidst growing challenges. As families faced the complexities of a NICU stay—including the heartbreaking loss of an infant—we provided a record level of aid. This year, we supported 628 families across our partner hospitals in Charlotte, NC, and Columbia, SC, bringing critical resources to more families than ever before.

At our newest partner hospital, Prisma Health, the full scope of our program has been successfully implemented at their Richland and Baptist Hospital NICUs. It has been an honor to expand our support to reach more NICU families in South Carolina this year and we are thankful for the opportunity to work alongside their exceptional team of social workers.

The "why" behind our mission is rooted in a core belief: no family should face barriers that prevent them from being a part of their infant's care. We strive to be a reliable resource for our hospital partners, providing NICU families with the practical support they need to navigate their NICU journey and know that they are not alone. We are especially thankful for our dedicated Program Manager, Sarah Turza, who works tirelessly to ensure families receive this crucial support.

The increasing needs of the NICU community can only be met through the incredible support of our sponsors, donors, volunteers, community partners, board of directors and staff. We are deeply grateful for the opportunity to work with so many of you this year.

Our mission would not be possible without the unwavering commitment of individuals and organizations who make our work possible.

As we approach our daughter's tenth birthday, we are humbled that her life and memory continue to live on in the families that Madelyn's Fund serves. From a simple meal offered to a family to easing the burden of funeral expenses for the bereaved, Madelyn's light continues to shine.



## AN UPDATE ON OUR NEWEST PARTNER HOSPITAL

In 2023, we began our partnership with Prisma Health's Richland and Baptist Hospital NICUs in Columbia, SC.

In February 2024, we expanded our full program to assist families in their units. Since that took effect earlier this year, we have provided assistance to 138 NICU families (a total of 407 since inception), including funding 17 funerals for families who suffered loss.

In addition to financial assistance,
Madelyn's Fund was able to gift \$12,720
to the Prisma Health Richland NICU to
purchase new recliners for their unit.
These new recliners will offer families
a comfortable place to bond with their
babies during visits, helping to create a
more supportive environment for both
parents and infants.

Highlights include our award-winning Drink Pink campaign, recognized with Share Charlotte's award for Best Nonprofit Fundraising Campaign, as well as NICU Awareness Month partnerships, Ellie & Zoe's Run, the March Madness Bracket Challenge, the Veronica Beard Shopping Event, the Pour Wars Event in Columbia and the Charlotte City Tennis Social. These efforts, alongside ongoing community support and partnerships with IIRA Skincare and Kangaroo Cozies, helped us raise **over \$70,000**, to expand our reach in our mission to assist NICU families.

#### BEREAVEMENT SUPPORT

Madelyn's Fund goes beyond financial assistance to offer meaningful support to NICU families in need. In collaboration with other local non-profits, Out of the Ashes and Mother of Wilde, we work together to send bereavement care packages to NICU families who have suffered a loss and offer memorial prints for families. In 2024, Madelyn's Fund also participated in a brand new event, a Bereaved Mother's Day Tea, hosted in partnership with several local organizations. This special event honored and celebrated motherhood for mothers grieving the loss of a child.



#### **NICU REUNION**

Connecting with NICU families is one of our favorite things at Madelyn's Fund. This fall, we had a wonderful afternoon attending the Hemby Children's Hospital NICU Reunion—the first in-person gathering in several years, and it was well worth the wait! The reunion held at Independence Park brought together former NICU families, doctors, nurses and support organizations to celebrate milestones and share their stories.



#### **HOLIDAYS**

The holidays can be an especially challenging time for NICU families and Madelyn's Fund works hard to bring cheer and comfort during this season. We brightened the holidays by delivering candy bags to families at our Charlotte Hospital partner NICUs. Thanks to our partnership with the Charlotte Skill Factory basketball program, we assembled hundreds of bags filled with candy to spread joy to families with an infant in the NICU over the holidays.

One of our most rewarding projects each year is working with the Levine Children's Hospital CVICU to bless a family for the holidays. This year, thanks to the overwhelming generosity of our community during our Giving Tuesday campaign, we were able to provide this special family with practical items and gifts this holiday season. This year's family faces the incredibly difficult challenge of caring for a child with a heart defect, the financial impact of a lengthy hospital stay and their struggles were further compounded by the devastation caused by Hurricane Helene. We are deeply grateful for the support that made this possible.
